State Representative Larry Taylor District 24, Galveston County

Rep. Larry Taylor is a lifelong Texan, born in southeast Texas and raised in Friendswood. He attended Baylor University where he received his BBA in 1982. Rep. Taylor and his wife Kerri, have three beautiful children: Trudy, Carly and Jake. He owns Truman Taylor Insurance Agency in Friendswood, an independent agency started by his father over 50 years ago.

Rep. Taylor is frequently recognized as a legislative champion for fiscal responsibility and conservative representation. Taylor is proud to have been named a "Taxpayer Advocate" by Texans for Fiscal Responsibility, a "Champion of Free Enterprise" by the Texas Association of Business, and a "Courageous Conservative" by the Texas Conservative Coalition. Locally, Rep. Taylor received the "2011 Citizen of the Year" award from the Galveston Daily News and most recently, The Sealy and Smith Foundation gave Taylor its "Texas Legislative Champion" award for his efforts to obtain the state support needed to repair the medical branch after Hurricane Ike and to secure the support needed to build the \$438 million Jennie Sealy Hospital.

Rep. Taylor serves as the Chairman of the House Elections Committee, Co-Chairman of the Windstorm Insurance Legislative Oversight Board, member of the House Insurance Committee, the House Select Committee on Voter Identification and Voter Fraud and the Energy Council. In 2011, Rep. Taylor was re-elected unanimously by his colleagues to serve a second term as Chairman of the House Republican Caucus. Rep. Taylor was elected in 2002 by District 24 in Galveston County and is serving his fifth term in the Texas House of Representatives as a member of the 82nd Legislature. Rep. Taylor is currently a candidate for Texas State Senate District 11.
